Bible study ever Sunday at 10.30am and 6.15pm - in the main church

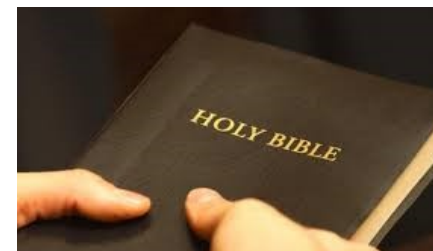
