November 2022 - Beadnell Beach

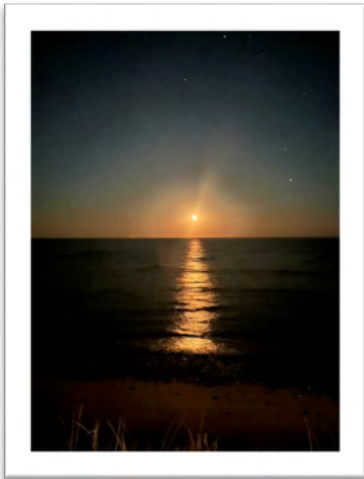
