They laid her body to rest on Christmas Eve. After some on-going eye problems she was diagnosed with a primary brain tumour on August 28th last year. She was 78. David's youngest daughter moved to a the house next door to help care for Zena . Zena wanted to be at home and decided against surgery and radiotherapy, which would have meant spending her last days in hospital. David's daughter from Australia, who is a nurse, immediately flew home, so that all 3 daughters could look after Zena. Zena and the daughters were adamant that David should continue his ministry and complete his scheduled meetings up to the end of November. Together they believed that, unless the Lord should miraculously intervene, they would let the Lord take Zena home in peace and without pain and that, to the end, Zena and the family would remain together. David's daughters and grandchildren are now taking care of him so that his ministry will continue. Please pray for David as he return to ministry in Switzerland in February, Israel in March.
